



## HOME HEALTH (HH) CARE SERVICES

HH services assists individuals to reach the fullest extent of their potential in the least restrictive environment, by assisting them to complete their personal cares/activities of daily living in their own homes. HHC also promotes and maintains health for the individuals by coordinating medical treatment with their physicians to ensure quality and continuity in their care.

HH offers skilled nursing and personal care services under several funding sources including Medicare, Medicaid, private insurance, county funds and private pay.

**Skilled Nursing** services are provided in accordance with physician's orders and includes assessing individual's health condition and providing medical treatments as needed.

**Home Health Care Aides** services are also provided in accordance with physician's orders and includes the activities of daily living.

Qualified RN's and Home Health Aides work as a team to provide quality care. Services are provided in accordance with physician's orders and include assessing an individual's health condition, providing medical treatments as needed, and educating individuals on medications and overall health.

Additional services provided by HH include:

**Respite Care Services** are provided to the individual that gives temporary relief to the usual caregiver. Respite care enables the individual to remain in their current living situation.

**Interim Medical Monitoring and Treatment (IMMT)** of a medical nature requiring specially trained caregivers beyond what is normally available in a daycare setting for persons age 20 and under. IMMT services shall provide support to enhance each individual's social, emotional, intellectual, and physical development.

**In Home Care Programming (IHCP)** is also available.
