



## **RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITY (RCF)**

The RCF is a community-integrated program offering a full array of services, both in-house, and through local community resources, to adults with disabilities requiring licensed residential treatment services.

CCI has three RCF's - Heritage Residence in New Hampton, Edinburgh Manor in Anamosa and Community Care of Marion Co. in Knoxville.

The RCF's well-trained staff, and home-like environment, provide each individual with support, supervision, training, and rehabilitation needed to avoid transfer to a more restrictive environment and to prepare for advancement to a more normalized and less restrictive community living arrangement. Services provided include training in living skills, social skills, and recreational skills. Some of our RCF's also offer vocational experience. Individual and family members are part of the Individual Program Plan (IPP) team and are encouraged to participate in all aspects of IPP development and implementation.

**Rehabilitation Activities:** Staff members are the primary care givers, teachers, trainers, and role models for individuals in the RCF. Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) provide each individual with the support and supervision consistent with his/her individual needs in the exercise of daily living activities.

**Recreation Services:** Programming is developed by the interdisciplinary team. It is then monitored and implemented by a Recreation Coordinator. All such programming is outcome based, and works towards each individual acquiring, and maintaining, the necessary skills to independently initiate, and complete, satisfying and rewarding recreational and leisure activities in both social and individual contexts.

**Education Services:** Some educational needs may be addressed by the interdisciplinary team through programming by the recreational coordinator or social worker or a formal referral for specific needs to another local agency.

### **Medication Services:**

All individuals medications are monitored and given by special trained certified medication aides.
